### **Job Summary:**

The Engineer works with the locomotive fireman and conductor on an oil fired steam locomotive for a historic passenger train. Shifts may be up to 12 hours per day, 4 or 5 days per week on a variable schedule. The job is physically demanding. The cab of the locomotive can reach temperatures of up to 120°F during the summer days. Must be able to work a flexible schedule that will include, weekend, holidays and some evenings.

### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Responsible for the safe operation of the locomotive and train
- Must perform daily mechanical inspections of the locomotive
- Maintain fire, steam pressure and water level in boiler
- Watch track ahead of train for obstructions or improper conditions
- Work under direct supervision of locomotive engineer and Superintendent of Railroad Operations
- Help diagnose mechanical problems and make repairs
- Good customer service skills
- Locomotive and passenger car maintenance on non-operating days
- Perform other duties as requested by the Superintendent of Railroad Operations
- Compliance with MRRR procedures, safety and operating rules
- Work with all departments
- Off Season – mechanical work on locomotives and passenger cars

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Physically able to do the work of an Engineer
- Experience working on historic steam and diesel locomotive
- Must be qualified as a Locomotive Fireman, 2 years minimum experience, on oil burning steam locomotives
