Job Summary: Responsible for the maintenance of the property's buildings, grounds and cleaning. Works as a team member of the Grounds Keeping & Building Maintenance Department.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Set-up and take-down of parking & boarding station and promotional signage.
- Set-up de-boarding barricades at the depot.
- Provide assistance as needed for passengers with special needs.
- Interact and assist with customer needs as necessary demonstrating superior customer service.
- Maintain outdoor picnic area.
- Mow and trim property grounds.
- Maintenance of property grounds to include, but not limited to: trash pick-up for all property locations, cleaning/weeding/watering of flower beds and potted plants.
- Clean property buildings to include, but not limited to: Elbe Public Restrooms and depot building, Mineral Public Restrooms and buildings, Eatonville office building.
- Participate in the construction, set-up and tear-down of event sites.
- Assist with parking as needed.
- Perform minor building and equipment repairs.
- Transport supplies to various departments as needed.
- Compliance with MRRR procedures, safety and operating rules.
