Job Summary:

Carman duties include routine maintenance of the passenger cars during our operation season as well as heavier mechanical repairs during our off season. Conductors are a component of a three person crew that works onboard the trains. Each train makes multiple round-trip rides to Mineral. Each shift can last up to twelve hours. Up to four shifts a week will be scheduled for a fulltime employee. Duties on the passenger train include but are not limited to coordination of train crew activities engaged in transporting passengers, inspecting and using equipment including connecting air hoses, coupling locomotive or cars, throwing switches, setting hand brakes and ensure proper working condition of the train. The conductor will assist passengers in boarding and de-boarding train and includes placing and retrieving wheelchairs in and out of the wheelchair lift. Conductors will also collect and punch tickets from passengers and respond to passengers questions regarding train rules and timetables and history of the railroad. Must be able to work a flexible schedule that will include weekends, holidays and some evenings.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Ability to be on your feet for the majority of the shift (8-12 hours)
- Lift a minimum of 75 lbs
- Will be responsible for performing brake tests, mechanical inspections and repairs on the rail cars
- Must have good mechanical aptitude, basic electrical knowledge, metal working skills; welding abilities are preferred
- Should possess strong customer service skills and be able to work in a team atmosphere
- Compliance to MRRR procedures, safety and operating rules
- Other duties as requested by supervisor
- Work with all departments
- Responsible for safe operation of the train
- Passenger car maintenance on non-operating days

- Ascends and descends train steps/ladders
- Walks on moving train
- Walk on uneven, graveled surfaces that are wet, slippery and sloped when carrying lantern and flashlight
- Lines track switches
- Lifts/lowers/carry “Frogs” to and from locomotive and track
- While on duty as conductor, must wear Conductor uniform

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Ability to communicate effectively in both written and spoken English
- Demonstrates organizational skills and ability to multi-task
- Must have ability to prioritize workload and have a practical, flexible and innovative work approach
- Ability to communicate successfully with a variety of personalities and ability to function as a member of a team
- Must be able to work a flexible schedule that will include weekend, holidays and some evenings
- Ability to work in daylight and darkness
