Experience the ride of your life!

Steam engine cab rides are available between Elbe Depot and the museum in Mineral on most train excursions. Ride alongside the engineer and fireman of a vintage steam locomotive onboard a scheduled excursion through the forests and foothills of Mt. Rainier. A one-way cab ride is approximately 30-35 minutes, and a Standard or First-Class ticket is required in advance to complete the round-trip experience. Please arrive at Elbe Depot 45 minutes prior to the train's departure.
